

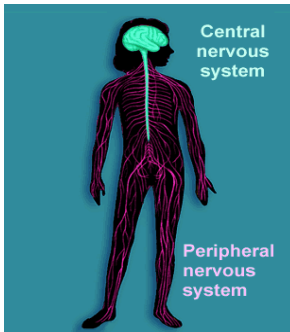
Ellen Barker, MSN, RN, APN, CNRN, CLCP, ABDA

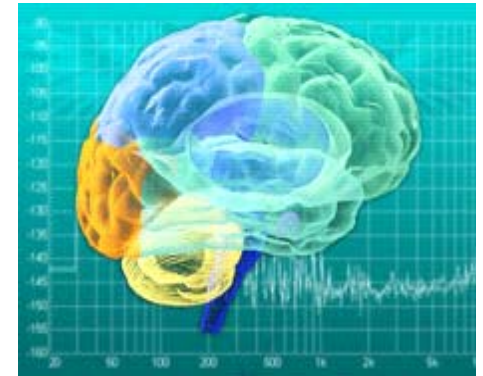
