Driving Directions To DePaul Ambulatory Care Center 11 Getty Ave, Paterson, NJ

- **From Route 80 East or West**
Take Exit 58A—Madison Avenue, Clifton exit. Go to the first traffic light (Dunkin Donuts on the corner), make a right onto Getty Avenue. Continue on Getty Ave, follow the black wrought iron fence, enter at the security booth. See parking directions below.
- **From Garden State Parkway North**
Take the Parkway North to Exit 155P (left exit) to Rte 20/Rte 80. Take the first exit Broad Street. Make a right at the end of the ramp. Pass the traffic light and bear left after the underpass onto Marshall Street. At the second light make a right onto Barclay St. At the end of the road make a left onto Main Street, move into the right lane. At the first traffic light make a right onto Mary St/Hospital Plaza. At the stop sign, make a right onto Getty Avenue and almost immediately make a left into the parking lot. See parking directions below.
- **From Garden State Parkway South**
Take Parkway exit 159, take Rte 80 West. Follow directions for Rte 80 above.
- **From Rte 4 West**
As soon as you pass over the Passaic River, make a right onto Rte 20 South to Rte 80 West. Follow directions above for Rte 80 above.
- **Parking Directions**
After the security booth park in any space available. Walk to the building with the green awning across from the security booth. Take elevator to the 2nd Fl, Registration Desk B.

Additionally, we provide parent education and support. Services are provided in homes, day care centers, and our own center. Through structured play activities and daily living functions, families learn to understand and improve their child's overall development.
