The oldest operated Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) in the State of New Jersey is located at St. Joseph's Regional Medical Center. We are staffed by a team of Board-certified neonatologists who provide excellent care for the most premature of infant or infants, in the case of multiples. If you are experiencing a high-risk pregnancy, we will meet with you before delivery and discuss the care of your infant(s).

Women in need of gynecological care can choose from our many qualified community

physicians. A specialty clinic in the hospital provides care for a woman experiencing incontinence. This service provides highly personalized care for each of our patients.

Additionally, we are proud of our affiliation with the Mount Sinai Medical Center, as we provide a four-year residency program for obstetrics and a fellowship in urogynecological care.
